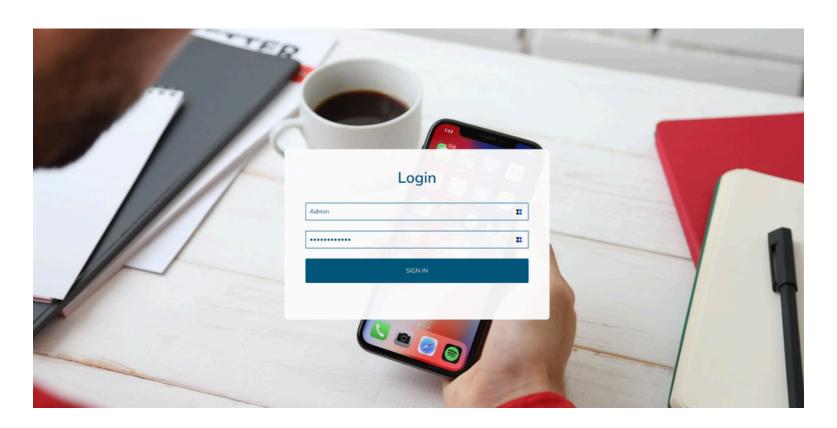


# Hunting App Operating Manual

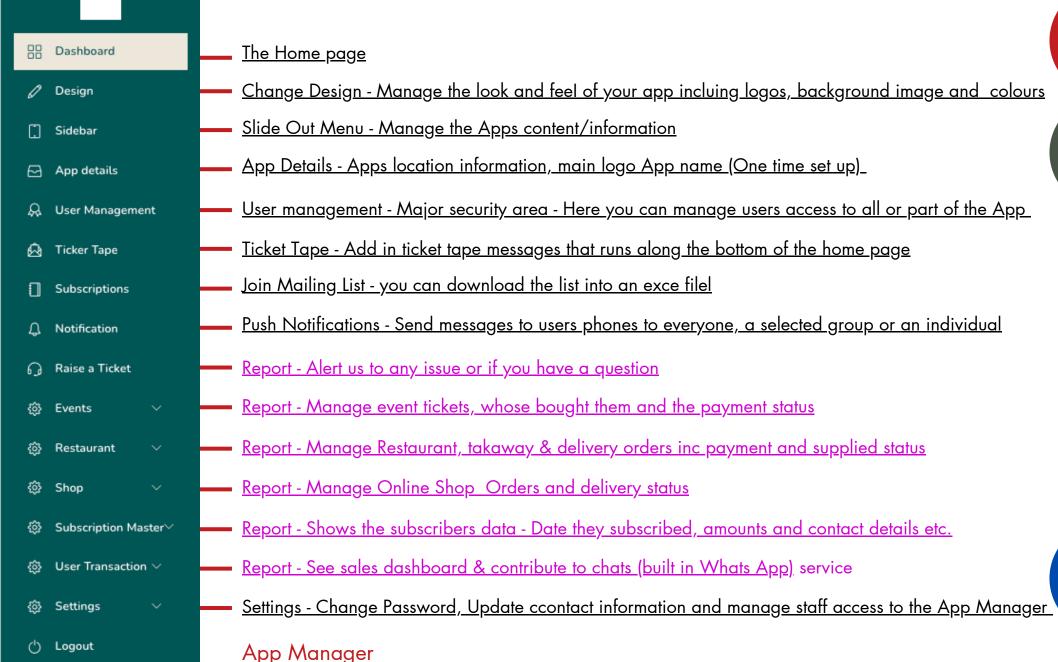
- 1. Enter your username (supplied)

#### Editor dashboard - First page you see



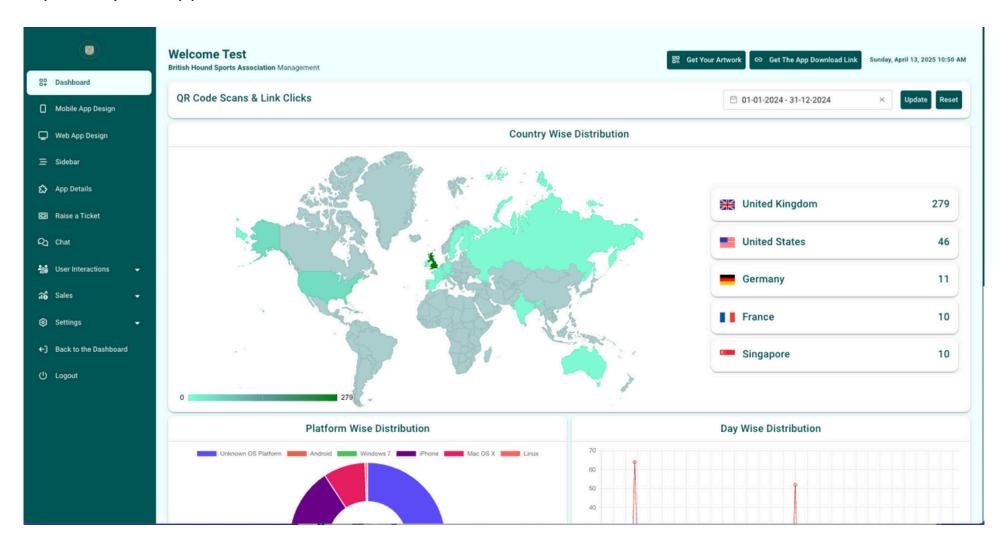
This is what you first see when logged in showing all the elements in the app editing suite.

#### Add Buttons to the Home page

You can add up to 3 buttons to the home page covering Calling, Direction & Share the app.

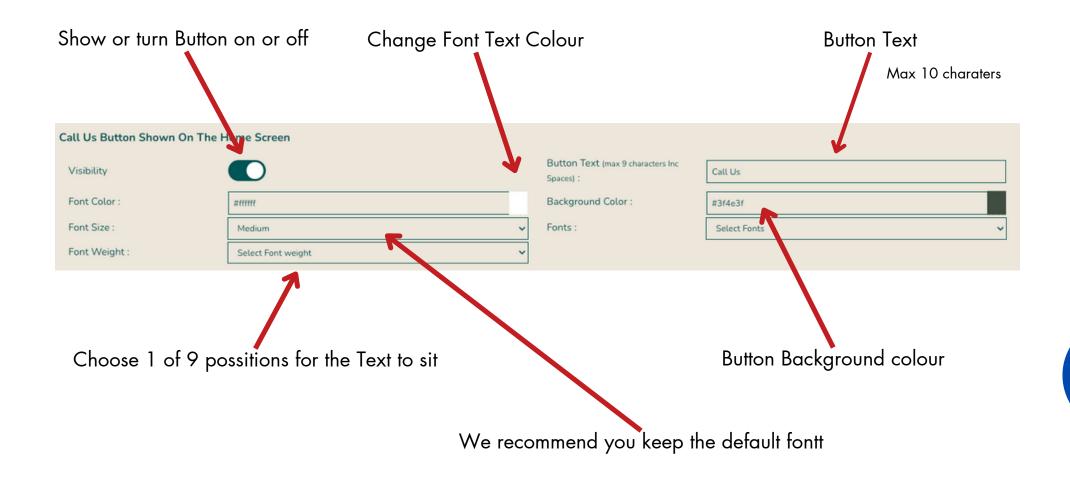
- Call Button takes telephone numbers from the Contact widget in the Information slide out menu
- Directions Button takes the location of each contact in the Contact widget
- Share Button allows you to forward a link to the App to anyone you wish to send it to.



#### Add an Action Buttons

You can add 1 action button to the homepage on any subject and you can link it to one of the following:

- Text
- a widget in the slide out menu or
- a URL



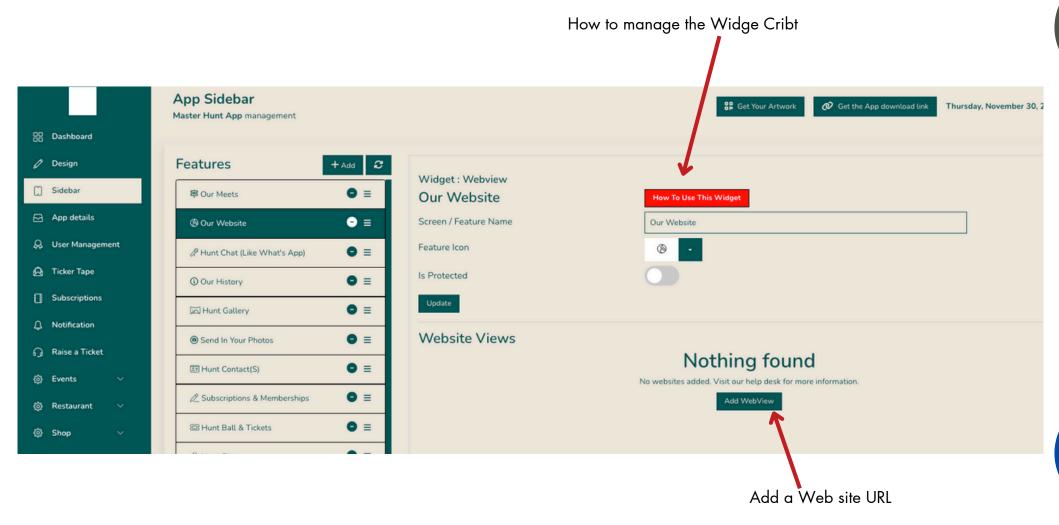
#### Slide Out - Widget Set Up

We have pre populated your app with BHSA approved widgets so all you have to do is populate your App with Hunt Information. This image shows you how to Add, delete, turn off and edit a widget in your app



#### Slide Out - Add Content Section

Once the widget is set up you can then add your information to it. If you use the red button it shows you in moment how to add information and save it



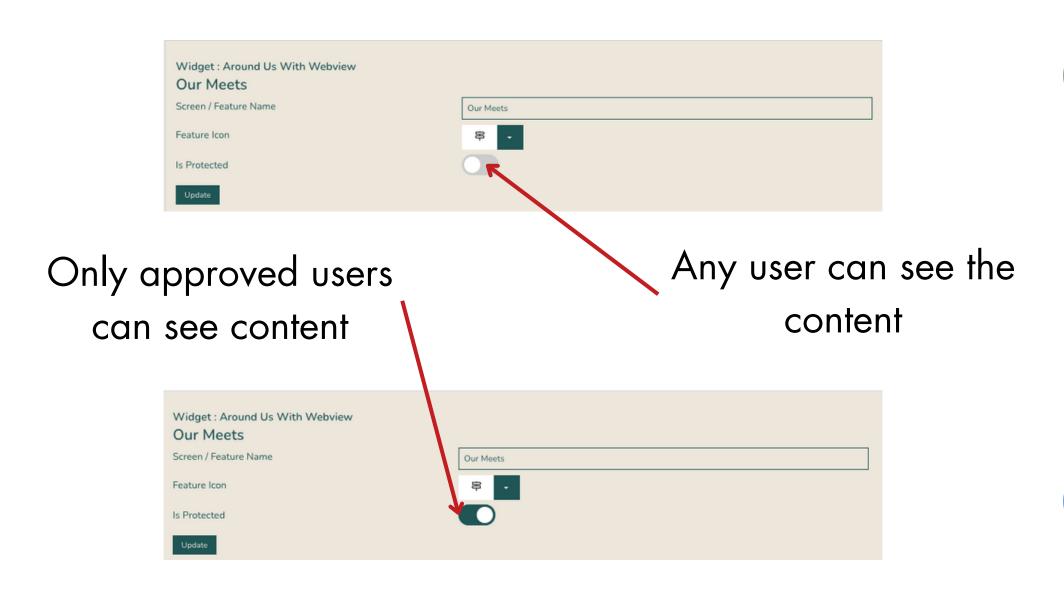
#### App Details

This is where you set up the main app information:

- App Name
- App Logo (not the home page logo)
- App Description
- Set the main location for the app by entering the address and postcode into the Search location field, Google will auto set the Latitude and Longitude - (Important as all measurements in the app work from this position)
- Contact email
- Privacy Policy URL You must have a link or use the BHSA one
- Terms & Conditions URL You must have a link or use the BHSA one
- Contact address which is prefilled from Google

### Protecting Information Widgets

Every information widget can be protected to only be viewed by approved users

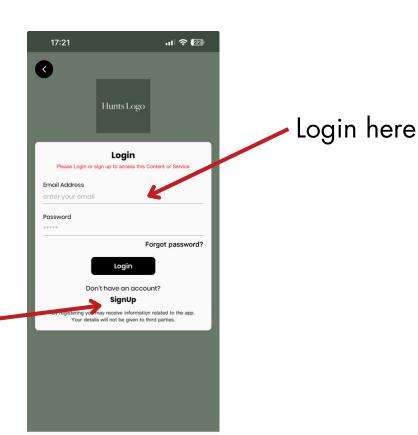


#### User management

When a user downloads the app they will be asked to set up an account with an email and a password only known to them so they can access various widgets requiring their details to opperate

When they submit their details they are classed as UNAPPROVED but that can still have access to:

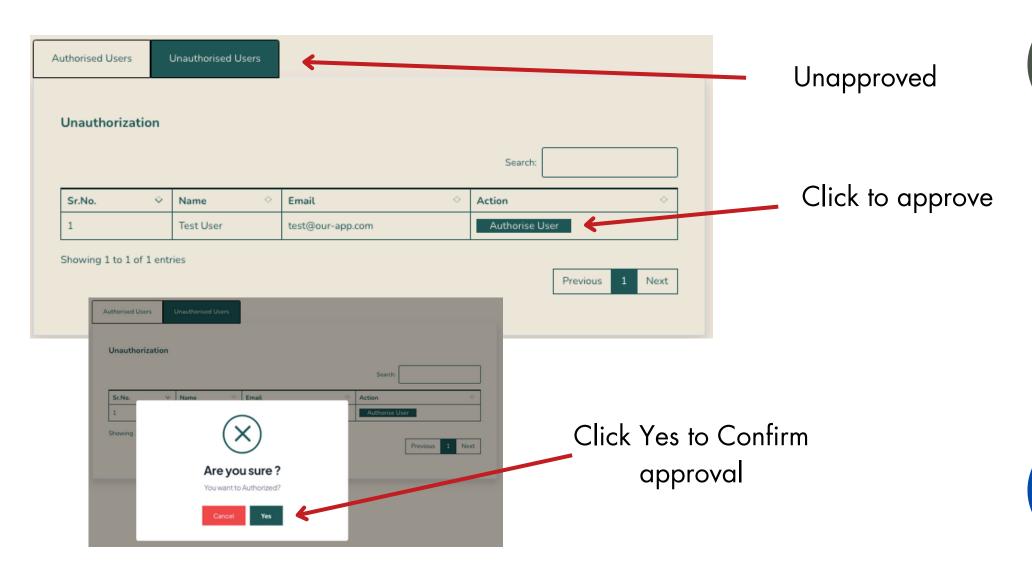
- Shopping

- Food ordering

#### Approving Users

You have to approve users before they can see protected widgets so you must be very careful you know the people and their contact details you are approving.

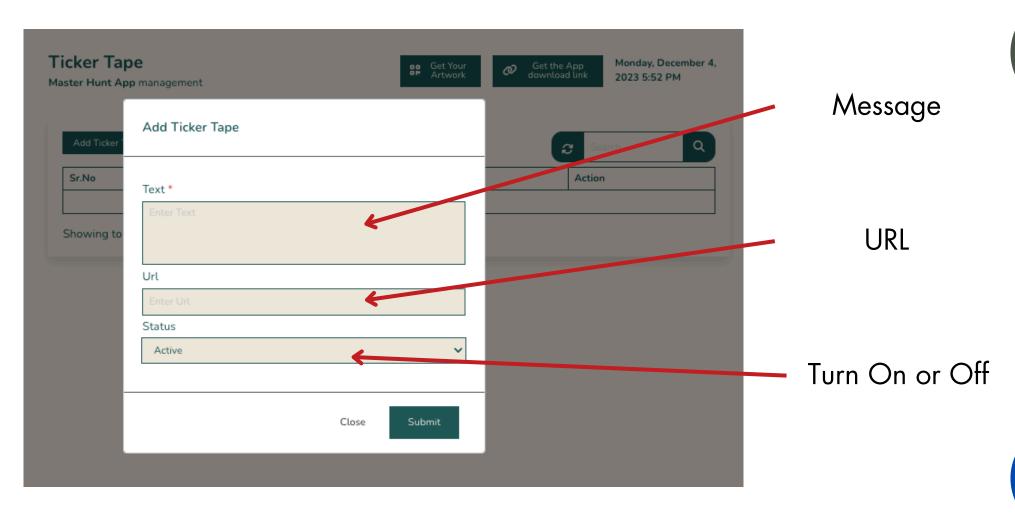

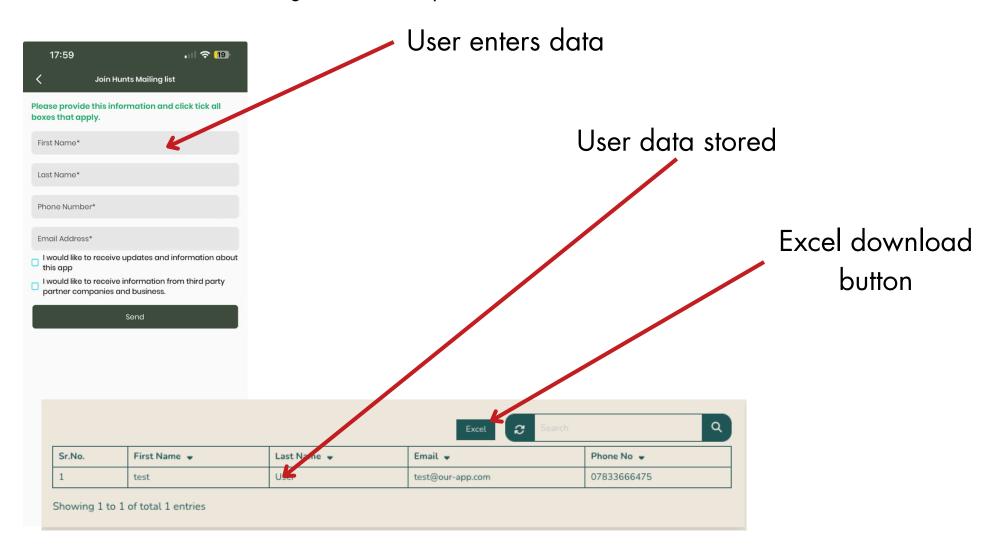
#### Ticket Tape

You can run short messages along the bottom of the home screen and link them a URL there is no limit to the number of messages but we recommend that you don't have more than 3 active at any one time



#### Join Mailing List

This is where the Join Mailing list data is kept



#### Push Notifications

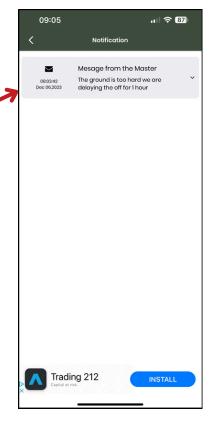
You can now send a push notification to all account holding App users in real time.

Push Notifications are popups that appear on your phone providing real time information.

An example could be your Master sends out a message at 0830 saying "the ground is to hard we are delaying the off for 1 hour"



When a message is sent it pops up on the home screen like this. Click on it and it opens the app taking you to the messaging page to view the message or a link

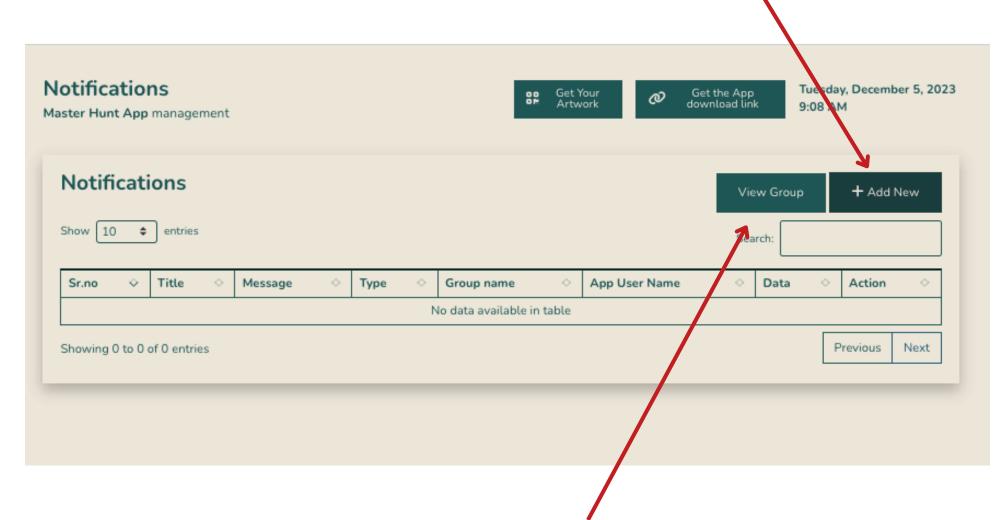

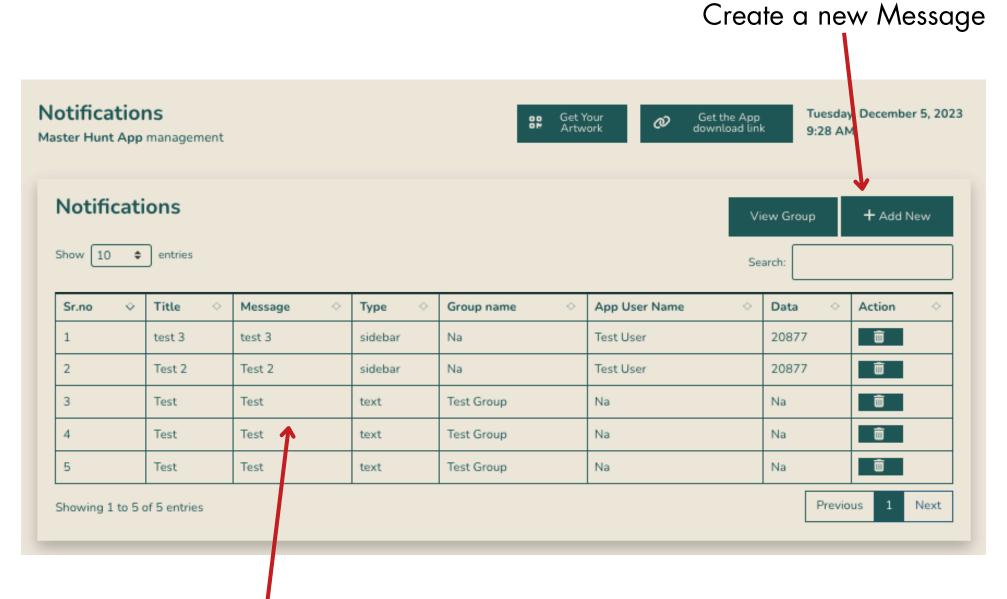

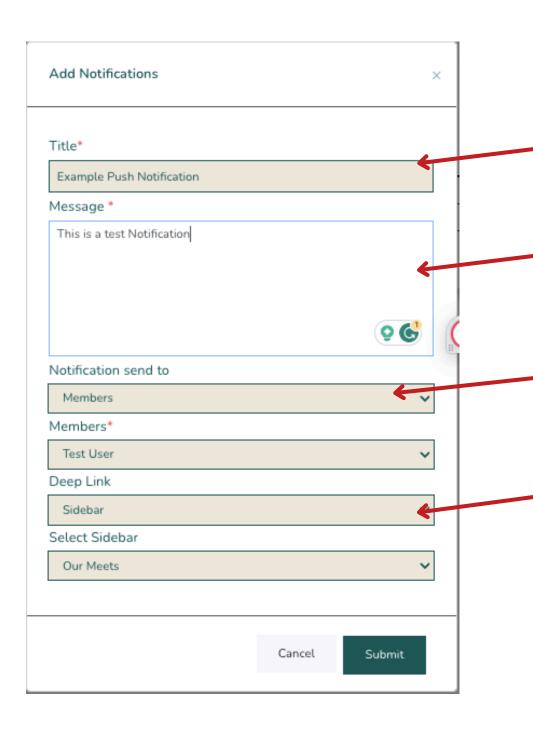
#### Create a group and add members

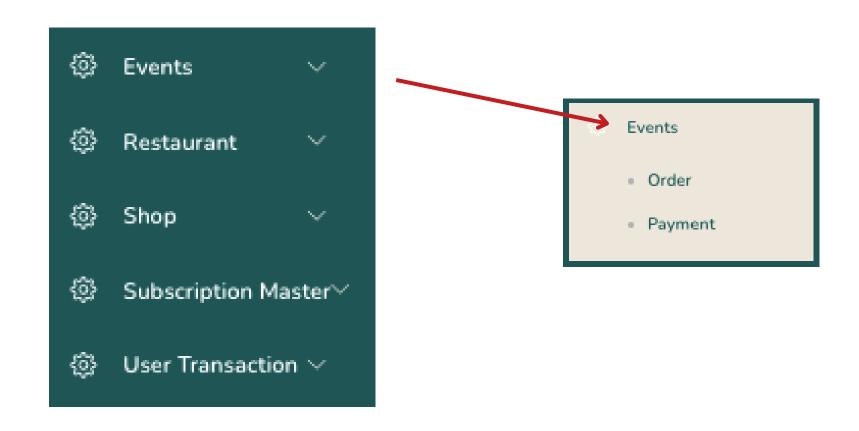

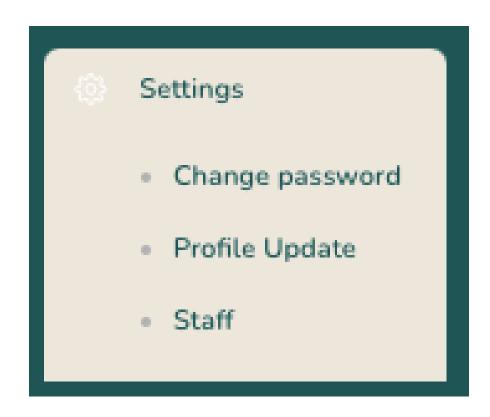
#### Reports

TRhgese sections are all reporting sales and transactions and delivery status, they are self explanatory



#### Settings

Allows you to change your password, Update basic contact details and give staff permissions to use the App Manager.

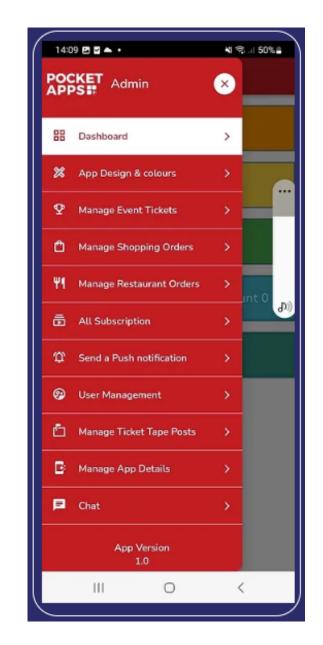


#### App Manager

App Manager is a separate App showing the Mobile version of the backend App Editor CMS, allowing your App to be edited from a mobile phone or tablet.

Staff can be awarded limited access to the App Manager. For example kitchen staff can see food orders coming in and update them as served or delivered when the food has been collected, delivered or sent to the table.

Doorman and Gate keepers can scan the users app QR code to retrieve tickets at the gate to a point to point or Hunt ball marking the ticket as used when they let someone in



## BHSA App Digital Security Guide

The following tips and tricks will help you maximise your digital security while using the BHSA app and minimise the risk of anti-hunt activist groups gaining access to sensitive information.

This advice is tailored to the BHSA app, although much of it is applicable across social media and other digital tools. For further information and advice, see the National Cyber Security Centre's <u>website</u>.

#### Advice for All Users

- ·Choose a strong password for your BHSA profile. Strong passwords are made up of numbers, letters, and special symbols (@!\*& etc.) Do not use words related to hunting or easily guessable personal details such as your name, address, or date of birth.
- Equally, make sure that the email account you are using for your BHSA profile is secure and has a strong password. You can use the website HavelBeenPwned to check whether your <u>email</u> or <u>password</u> has been involved in a data breach. If it has, be sure to update your password.
- ·Finally on passwords, make sure your phone and any other devices you use the BHSA app on has a password and automatically locks after a minute of no activity. Contrary to popular belief, most hacks are 'social hacks', meaning that hackers still information by physically stealing or looking through devices.
- If you believe that your account has been hacked, deactivate your BHSA account if possible and alert a BHSA officer to receive further instructions.

#### Advice for Hunt Managers

- Only invite users to join your hunt's mini-app if you can personally verify their identify. Do not send an invite link without visually identifying who you are sending it to, either in-person or over video call.
- · Where possible, send invitation links and any other sensitive information (passwords etc.) only via encrypted messaging services such as WhatsApp and Signal.
- ·Flag any suspicious behaviour with a BHSA officer. If you notice an increase in anti-hunt activists at meets or social events, review who has access to your mini-app and check their identities. If in doubt, flag this with the BHSA.
